General

- Introduce Team Officials
- Players names
- Pick a Team Name
- Explain Team Page on website:
 - o Team Official contact details: must log in to see contact numbers/email address
 - Schedule
- Parent/Responsible Adult Designate: If a parent is NOT IN ATTENDANCE for a game, the coach/manager MUST be informed of the designated responsible adult for that child, in case of injury or emergency.
- All players must wear shin pads and some form of shoe
- All players should have a water bottle
- All players should be dressed for weather
- If the a coach/assistant coach is unable to make a game, the Team Manager or a parent will be asked to step into the role
- Preferably no Dogs at the field
- Rainouts: Check website for field status. No 'Rain Day' if game day cancelled. Coaches can also cancel due to weather if too cold for the younger children. Team Manager will notify the team – do not call us, we will call you. Game is one if no call 20 minutes prior to start
