4.1.General Update

- 4.2.U5 Academy - A lesson plan will be given to the coaches to execute. Coaches will submit their own lesson plan as the season progresses to see how they are developing as a coach. Equipment is good, but sturdier cones are needed. A 15 minute scrimmage will be held at the end of each session.
- 4.3.U7 Academy - Similar to U5, but each session will be half practice, half game. If possible, moving the U7's from Gobeil would be ideal. There is simply not enough parking, especially for U11 games that take place immediately after.
- 4.4.Techical sessions - U13 sessions will be back for Outdoor and hope for interest. Will see how it goes and adjust accordingly. We have to figure out how to get it through to parents that players must be registered via the website for Tech sessions. They cannot just show up. Eddie is not able to run a session with 50 kids. It was suggested that kids not registered be admitted on a first come first serve basis with a max number of participants. There is no Tech for U7 given the new Academy style approach to the season.
