10. Indoor 2020/21

10.1. General Discussion

Registrations are down across EMSA. We will issue refunds if the season is cancelled due to Covid-19. There is a 12 player limit for teams. All practices will be at the BSRC fieldhouse this season. You can wear flat shoes or turf shoes on the turf in the fieldhouse. The current rule is that one parent per player will be allowed to stay and watch the games at the Edmonton Soccer Dome or the Edmonton Soccer Centres. People should not show up for their games any earlier than 15 minutes before game time. Only six people in a locker room at a time. Come dressed to play. There will be four teams in a group. You will play a round robin with those four teams, followed by a two week break, then play four new teams. Fees have gone up partly because of the increased cost of using the BSRC for practices instead of school gyms. That is roughly \$40 per player. Also, less people allowed on teams means we have less players to spread the costs out.
