### Manager Information

### T-shirt Options

### Payment

Payment must be made before you will be assigned a division in the tournament. Only once payment has been received will a team be guaranteed a spot in the tournament.

### Team Name

Team Names can be changed in the registration form up to August 15, 2025. After that date, the team name will be assigned for the schedule.

### Rules

#### Continuous play

Continuous play will take place for age groups U7 and U9. This means that coaches, parents, or any other volunteer will be on the sidelines, helping to keep the ball in bounds. If there is a goal scored, the scoring team will be asked to retreat to allow the other team to carry the ball forward.

A Maximum of 9 teams will be added to the waitlist with full payment required to hold their spot.

No refunds will be given to teams.

If the event is cancelled for any reason, a new date will be picked before refunds will be considered.
